STHS Hair Band Challenge

As of October 16, 2023, we have 100 band and color guard students. We have only received contribution payments from 30 students, which amounts to \$17,000 of the \$71,000 requested this year from dues. Everyone's contributions help the bands rock on.

Let's reach a goal of **85% participation by November 1** and raise **\$60.000+!**
